There will be a lottery drawing Friday night at 7 PM for trivia seating and your placement in the Token Parade. At 8:30 PM join us for music and dancing with **Brant Butte**, **Let's Dance DJ**. The dance party will be "**The Past Rocks**". Come dressed up as one of your favorite people in history! Come dressed up as JFK, Eleanor Roosevelt or the Wright Brothers; the choice is up to you!
