

Tacoma Yacht Club's Daffodil Weekend is rapidly approaching, and we would like to cordially invite you to join us in celebrating the annual Daffodil Marine Festival and Parade. This year's theme is "Bloom Where the World Takes You."

The basin crew will be ready to welcome visiting boaters beginning at noon on Thursday, April 16th. We will find moorage for all boats; however, we cannot always guarantee power, and the use of a diesel generator can only be used if it does not pose a carbon monoxide health risk to others. Also, we cannot guarantee pet-friendly access to shore, so please consider before bringing your dogs.

<u>Friday night at 7pm</u> there will be a **competition** for trivia seating and your placement in the Token Parade. At <u>7:30pm</u> join us for music and dancing at our **Neon Nights** themed dance party! The Daffodil Chairs and Co-Chairs will be **awarding the best costume(s)** of the evening, so come prepared to compete for the top spot and to dance the night away!

A highlight of Daffodil is the **Token Parade** (1:30pm) followed immediately by **Trivia** on Saturday afternoon, April 18th 2pm-4pm. Please take careful note of the following:

- Limited bar menu food, beer, wine, and Daffy Drinks
- Trivia will be Pub-style
- Each club's trivia team will consist of no more than four people (including Token)
- Teams will be seated at tables determined by the previous night's competition
- Other club members will be seated around the ballroom to cheer on their team
